### Accessing Degree Works:

The following are directions on how to login into Degree Works. If you are a WCC student.

1. Sign into MyWCC using your MyWCC username (eg. TSMIT12345) and password.
2. Scroll down the page.

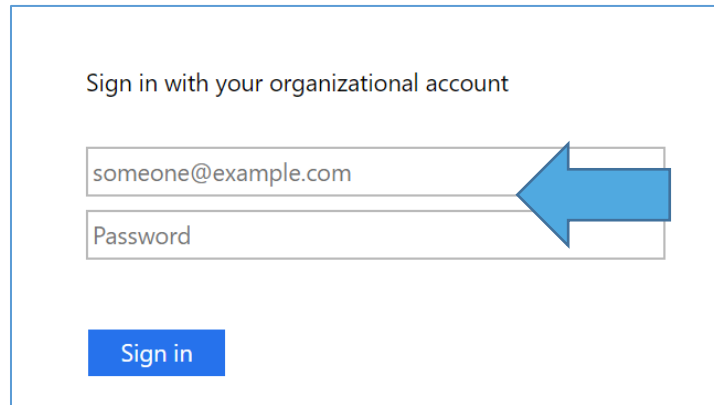
4. Select “Westchester” from the campus drop down menu.

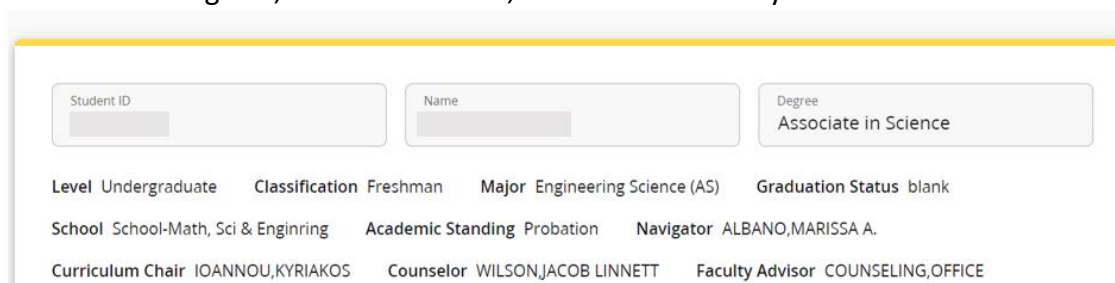
## What is Degree Works?

Degree Works, is a web-based Degree Audit responsive dashboard that allows students to view their progress towards a degree. Degree Works lists all of your requirements including: courses taken, courses currently being taken, transfer credits and much more.

## Degree Works Sections:

There are two sections of Degree Works: Worksheets and Plans

9. Worksheets – are also referred to the academic audit contain the student header, degree progress indicator, degree audit blocks, notes, legend and what-if tool.
  - a. **Student header** which includes your:
    - Student ID Number, Name
    - Major, School
    - Classification
    - GPA (need at least a 2.0 to graduate)
    - Academic Standing (Warning, Probation)
    - Navigator, Curriculum Chair, Counselor & Faculty Advisor



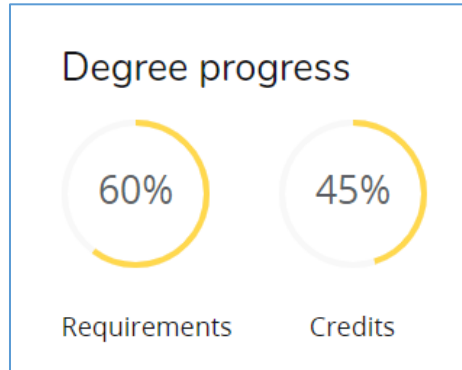

- b. **Degree Process Indicator** - reflects how close to graduation you are as a percent to credits and requirements.



- c. **Degree audit blocks** – contain sections called degree blocks that contain the requirements to complete your degree or certificate.

- f. **What-If tool** – assists students in identifying what courses/requirements are needed should they change their major. The tool is located between the student header and degree progress indicator.



Step 1: Select “What If”.

Step 2: Chose the desired “Catalog Year” (term).

Step 3: Chose the desired “Major” and “Concentration” (if applicable).

Step 4: Select “Process”.

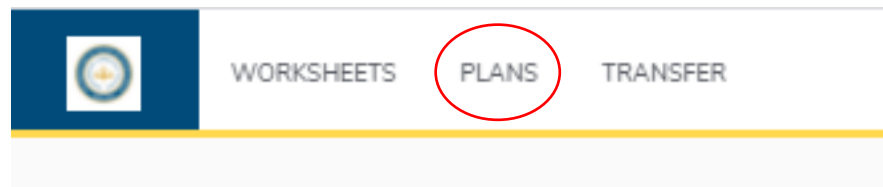
- a. This will generate an audit for the desired major and or concentration.
- b. Note that you will need to consult with your counselor or curriculum chair to change your major.

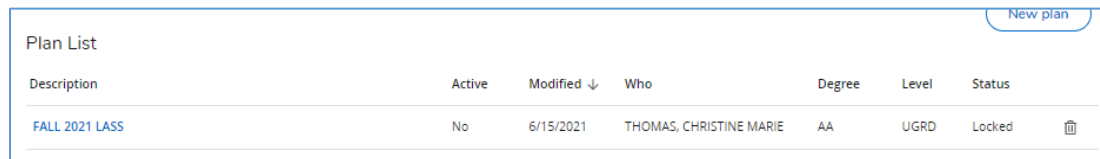

Step 1: Select the “Plan” Tab.

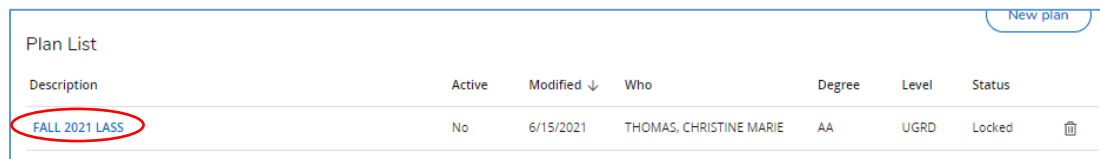
