NetTutor: How do I access NetTutor in Brightspace?

- Log into Brightspace & select your course.
- Navigate to "Content": Once in Brightspace, click on "Content" at the top of your course page. You will find the "NetTutor-Online Tutoring Services" module under the "Table of Content." If the "NetTutor" module is not available, contact your instructor to enable it.



• Access NetTutor: Click on "NetTutor - WES" within the module to go directly to the NetTutor site.



- Choose a Tutoring Option:
 - Select "NetTutor Tutoring Center" for subjects other than writing.
 - Select "NetTutor Writing Center" for help with writing.

- Select "Drop in and Meet with a Live Tutor" to meet with a tutor and have a live virtual session. To start a live audio/video tutoring session, follow these steps:
 - 1. At the beginning of the meeting, ask your tutor to enable the audio and video features.
 - 2. A whiteboard will appear with a message that says, "Join a video chat". Click on this message.
 - 3. Ensure your Audio and Video settings are correctly set up to join the audio/video conference.

To check the availability of a live tutor, click on "Drop-In Tutoring Hours" at the top right of the dashboard.



- Select "Drop off a Question" to receive feedback from a tutor.
- Accessing Your Activity: NetTutor keeps all your activities in your locker, where you can watch videos from previous sessions, retrieve your reviewed paper, and review feedback on dropped-off questions.
